This letter is in response to your request of information regarding Conflict of Minerals from Congo and adjoining countries as per reference given hereabove. The following statements are in support of your request.

Based on the information provided to Everel Group SpA by its raw material suppliers, we confirm that: i) tin, tantalum, tungsten, gold in their compound and mica, in case intentionally added in the metal parts used in our products as per description mentioned above, do not originate from the Democratic Republic of Congo or from any adjoining country. A CMRT per product category of supplied components involved can be prepared on demand.

ii) cobalt is not intentionally added in any component used in our products as per description mentioned above.
